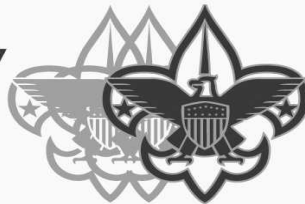

## Think Summer!

### A message from Scott Keeve

There will be a Summer Camp **parent meeting on Tuesday, Feb. 17** during our regularly scheduled scout meeting. This meeting is for the parents of scouts that are planning on attending summer camp on July 5-11.

A presentation on **Camp Decorah** in Holmen, WI will be given, with detailed information regarding preparation and planning for your scout's week of summer fun and adventure. Topics to be discussed include costs, medical exam requirements, healthcare/prescription medication issues, merit badge registration, 1st year Scout programs, food/dietary restrictions, extracurricular activities, as well as parent involvement.

For those scouts that have attended Camp Decorah in the past, they will find numerous improvements and upgrades to the facilities. Our camp site is centrally located, with all activities within a short distance. The boys can walk to every activity and to the new Dining Hall. There are planned events in the evenings that include a pool party, barbeque, and sports. Of course, the rifle and shotgun range is available in the evening for open shooting, for those interested.

**We would like to get a commitment as soon as possible** from each scout that will be attending summer camp, along with a deposit of \$100. We will be able to begin registering our scouts for activities and merit badges as of March 2. Since this process is first come, first served, the sooner we can have a camp roster prepared, the better. We will make every effort to get all scouts into their program of choice. Please review the list of merit badges offered at the camp with your son. It is important that your son think about what badges he would like to register for, so we can sign him up as soon as **registration begins on March 2.**

## BSA Troop 75 Recharter

It's that time again....2009 Recharter for Troop 75! Registration began in January and will end March 3, 2009. The annual recharter fee is \$75. However, due to the SPECTACULAR job the scouts did this year in fundraising (Pancake Breakfast), the Troop is subsidizing \$50 for scouts who participated in fundraising this year. So, the following are the 2009 recharter fees:

- \$ 25** if your scout completed the required 4 selling sessions for Troop 75's Pancake Breakfast.
- \$150** if your scout did not complete 4 selling sessions for Troop 75's Pancake Breakfast.
- \$ 75** for scouts joining the Troop.

Please note that scouts may use money in their scout accounts to pay towards the recharter fee. Please coordinate the use of scout account funds with Treasurer Kathy Meyers.

Checks for the recharter fee can be brought to Kathy Meyers at the weekly meeting or mailed to: Kathy Meyers, 1548 Hampton Court, Naperville, IL 60565. **All recharter fees must be received no later than March 3, 2009.**

Please make checks payable to Troop 75 and note your son (s) name on the check.
