The Potawatomi Trails District is hosting the **Merit Badge University (MBU) on Saturday, Feb. 28th** at York High School in Elmhurst. This is a great opportunity for our Scouts to earn up to 4 merit badges. Registration information will not be sent out until mid-December. Last year, the cost was \$18 for early registration or \$25 afterwards. This cost includes a hot lunch and MBU patch. This program is all day (8am-4pm) if four badges are earned.
